Train services resume through Leamington Spa and Banbury

CrossCountry is again able to provide customers with a normal train service between Manchester and the South Coast and between Reading and Newcastle after the railway line between Leamington Spa and Banbury reopened on 13 March.

After almost six weeks of extensive work by Network Rail engineers following a landslip that blocked the line at Harbury on 31 January, the line was open again on Friday 13 March, three weeks ahead of earlier estimates. While this work was going on, customers were provided with an express road replacement service linking the two stations and connecting into onward trains to complete their journeys.

CrossCountry would like to thank our customers for their patience and understanding while these essential works were completed, and Network Rail for reopening the line before the busy Easter holidays.
