



Changes to train times

Saturday 6 April to Thursday 2 May 2019

Major track improvement work will be taking place at the locations detailed below during this period. The following details will result in changes to the published timetable. You can check your journey at crosscountrytrains.co.uk or call National Rail Enquiries on 03457 48 49 50.

- A Stoke on Trent**
Saturday 6 from 2215 and all day Sunday 7 April
Trains will divert not to call at Stoke on Trent and Macclesfield. Journey times will remain unaffected. Rail replacement road transport will operate between:
-Stafford, Stoke on Trent and Macclesfield.
-Stoke on Trent, Macclesfield and Stockport.
- B Nottingham**
Monday 29 April to Thursday 2 May from 2300 to 0510 each night
The 2309 Birmingham New Street to Nottingham will terminate at Derby. Rail replacement road transport will operate from Derby to Nottingham.
- C Winchester**
Saturdays 6, 27 and Sundays 7, 28 April
Trains will divert not to call at Winchester and Southampton Airport Parkway. Journey times will be extended by approximately 45 minutes. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Winchester and Southampton Central.
- D Sheffield**
Sundays 7, 14 April
Reading/ Birmingham New Street - Newcastle services will start and terminate at Derby. Plymouth to Scotland services will divert via an alternative route calling additionally at Doncaster. Journey times will be extended by one hour.
- E Nottingham**
Sunday 7 April
Rail replacement road transport will operate between Derby and Nottingham.
- F Cardiff Central**
Sunday 7 April
Journey times will be extended by a few minutes between Cardiff Central and Gloucester.
- G Glasgow Central**
Saturday 20 & All Sundays in April
Rail replacement road transport will operate between Motherwell and Glasgow Central.
- H Guildford**
Sunday 7 April
The 1214 Guildford to Newcastle and 1735 Newcastle to Guildford will operate between Derby and Reading only. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Guildford and Wokingham.
- I Leeds**
Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 April from 0001 to 0540 each night
The 0531 Leeds to Glasgow will depart a few minutes later from Leeds and run as scheduled from York.
- J Stamford**
Sunday 14 April
Rail replacement road transport will operate between Ely, March, Peterborough and Stamford.
- K Winchester**
Sundays 14, 21 April
Trains will divert not to call at Basingstoke, Winchester and Southampton Airport Parkway. Journey times will be extended by one hour. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Reading, Basingstoke and Winchester.
- L Coventry**
Friday 19 to Sunday 21 April
Trains will divert not to call at Coventry and Birmingham International. Journey times will remain unaffected. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Leamington Spa, Coventry and Birmingham International.
- M Newport**
Friday 19 to Monday 22 April
Rail replacement road transport will operate between Chepstow, Caldicot, Lydney. Severn Tunnel Junction and Newport. The 0520 Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central will not run on Friday/Monday. Rail replacement road transport will operate from Bristol Temple Meads 0520, Bristol Parkway 0540 to Newport 0618 (arr).
- N Wakefield Westgate**
Sundays 21, 28 April
Trains will divert not to call at Wakefield Westgate. Journey times will be extended by a few minutes. Change at Leeds/Doncaster for rail services to Wakefield Westgate.
- O Newport**
Saturday 27 April
The 0700 Cardiff Central to Manchester Piccadilly and 1705 Manchester Piccadilly to Cardiff Central will start and terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Bristol Parkway and Newport.
- P Castle Cary**
Saturdays 6, 13 April
The 0608 Bristol Temple Meads to Plymouth will depart a few minutes later and runs as scheduled from Taunton.
