



Changes to train times

Saturday 1 June to Friday 5 July 2019

Major track improvement work will be taking place at the locations detailed below during this period. The following details will result in changes to the published timetable. You can check your journey at crosscountrytrains.co.uk or call National Rail Enquiries on 03457 48 49 50.

A Bristol Parkway Sunday 2 June

Trains will divert via an alternative route calling additionally at Newport and Gloucester. Journey times will be extended by one hour.

B Wakefield Westgate Sunday 2 June until 1600 and Sundays 9, 16 June

Trains will divert not to call at Wakefield Westgate. Rail replacement road transport will operate between
- Leeds and Wakefield Westgate
- Sheffield and Wakefield Westgate.

C Cheltenham Spa Monday 3 to Thursday 6 June from 2155 to 0555 each night

The 1500 Glasgow Central to Bristol Temple Meads, 1707 Edinburgh to Bristol Temple Meads and 2020 Paignton to Birmingham New Street will divert via an alternative route calling additionally at Gloucester. Journey times will be extended by up to 40 minutes.

D Southampton Central Sunday 9 June until 0910

Saturday: The 1827 Manchester Piccadilly to Bournemouth will terminate at Southampton Central.
Sunday: The 0920 Southampton Central to Manchester Piccadilly and 0940 Bournemouth to Manchester Piccadilly will start from Eastleigh and Southampton Central respectively. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Bournemouth and Southampton Central and from Southampton Central to Eastleigh.

E Cardiff Central Sundays 9, 16 June

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Newport and Cardiff Central.

F Oxford Sundays 23, 30 June

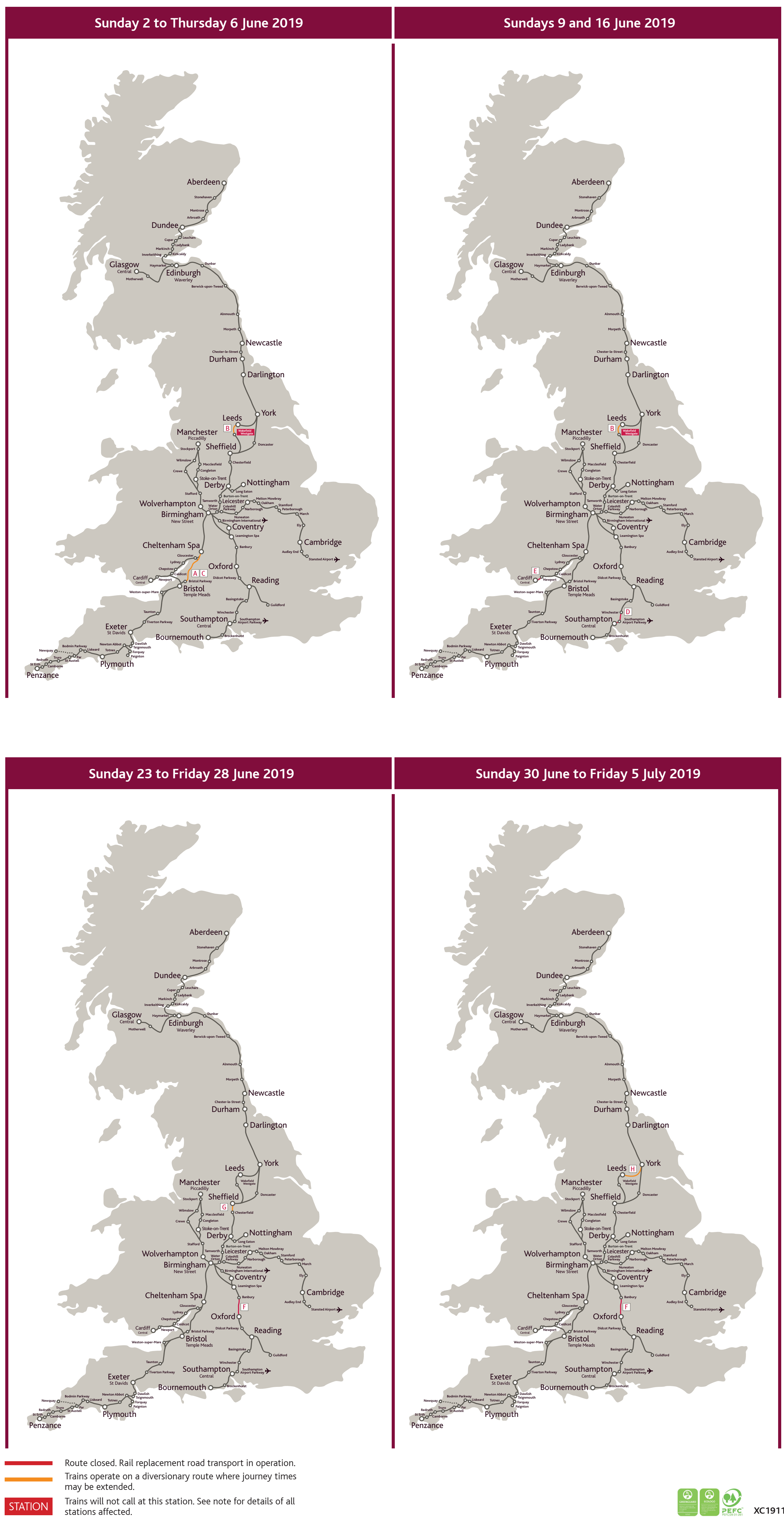
Rail replacement road transport will operate between Oxford and Banbury.

G Sheffield Tuesday 25 to Friday 28 June from 0030 to 0630 each night

The 0559 Sheffield to Reading will depart Sheffield a few minutes later and run as scheduled from Chesterfield.

H Leeds Tuesday 2 to Friday 5 July from 0001 to 0540 each night

The 0534 Leeds to Glasgow Central will depart a few minutes later and run as scheduled from York.
