

# CHANGES TO TRAIN TIMES.

Saturday 8 January – Thursday 3 February 2022.

Major track improvement work will be taking place at the locations detailed below during this period. The following details will result in changes to the published timetable.

**A Stonehaven**  
Saturday 8 & Sundays 9, 16, 23, 30 January

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Dundee and stations to Aberdeen.

**B Paignton**  
Saturdays 8, 15 & Sundays 9, 16 January

Bus services will operate between Newton Abbot, Torquay and Paignton.

**C University**  
Sundays 9, 16, 23 January

Trains will not call at University. Trains Rail replacement road transport will operate between Birmingham New Street and University.

**D Bristol Parkway**  
Sundays 9, 30 January

Trains will not call at Bristol Parkway. Journey times will be extended by one hour. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads.

**E Birmingham New Street Platform 4**  
Until 6 February

Trains on routes between Leicester – Birmingham New Street & Nottingham – Cardiff Central will be retimed by a few minutes.

**F Stansted Airport**  
Saturdays 15, 22, 29 & Sundays 16, 23, 30 January

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Cambridge and Stansted Airport.

**G Melton Mowbray**  
Sunday 16 January

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Leicester and Melton Mowbray.

**H Leeds**  
Sunday 16 January until 1010

0918 Leeds to Edinburgh Waverley will depart Leeds a few minutes earlier than normal. The 0935 York to Plymouth will start from Leeds.

**I Banbury**  
Sunday 16 January until 1300. Sundays 23, 30 January

Sunday 16 January. Rail replacement road transport will operate between

Leamington Spa, Banbury and Oxford. Sundays 23, 30 January. Rail replacement road transport will operate between -Birmingham International and Leamington Spa. -Birmingham International and Banbury -Coventry, Leamington Spa and Banbury.

**J Macclesfield**  
Sundays 23, 30 January

Trains will not call at Stoke on Trent and Macclesfield. Journey times remain unaffected with services calling at Wilmslow. Rail replacement road transport will operate between -Wilmslow, Macclesfield and Stoke -Macclesfield, Stoke and Stafford.

**K Dawlish**  
Saturday 22 January from 2150

The 1508 Edinburgh Waverley to Plymouth will run a few minutes later from Newton Abbot.

**L Totnes**  
Monday 24 – Thursday 27 January from 1925 to 0455 each night

Late evening trains to Plymouth will arrive a few minutes later than normal.

**M Winchester**  
Monday 24 - Thursday 27 January from 2250 to 0500 each night

The 1927 Manchester Piccadilly to Southampton Central will not call at Winchester and Southampton Airport Parkway. Journey time will be extended by 45 minutes. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Winchester and Southampton Airport Parkway.

**N Darlington**  
Saturday 29 - Sunday 30 January

Rail replacement road transport will operate between York, Darlington, Durham and Newcastle.

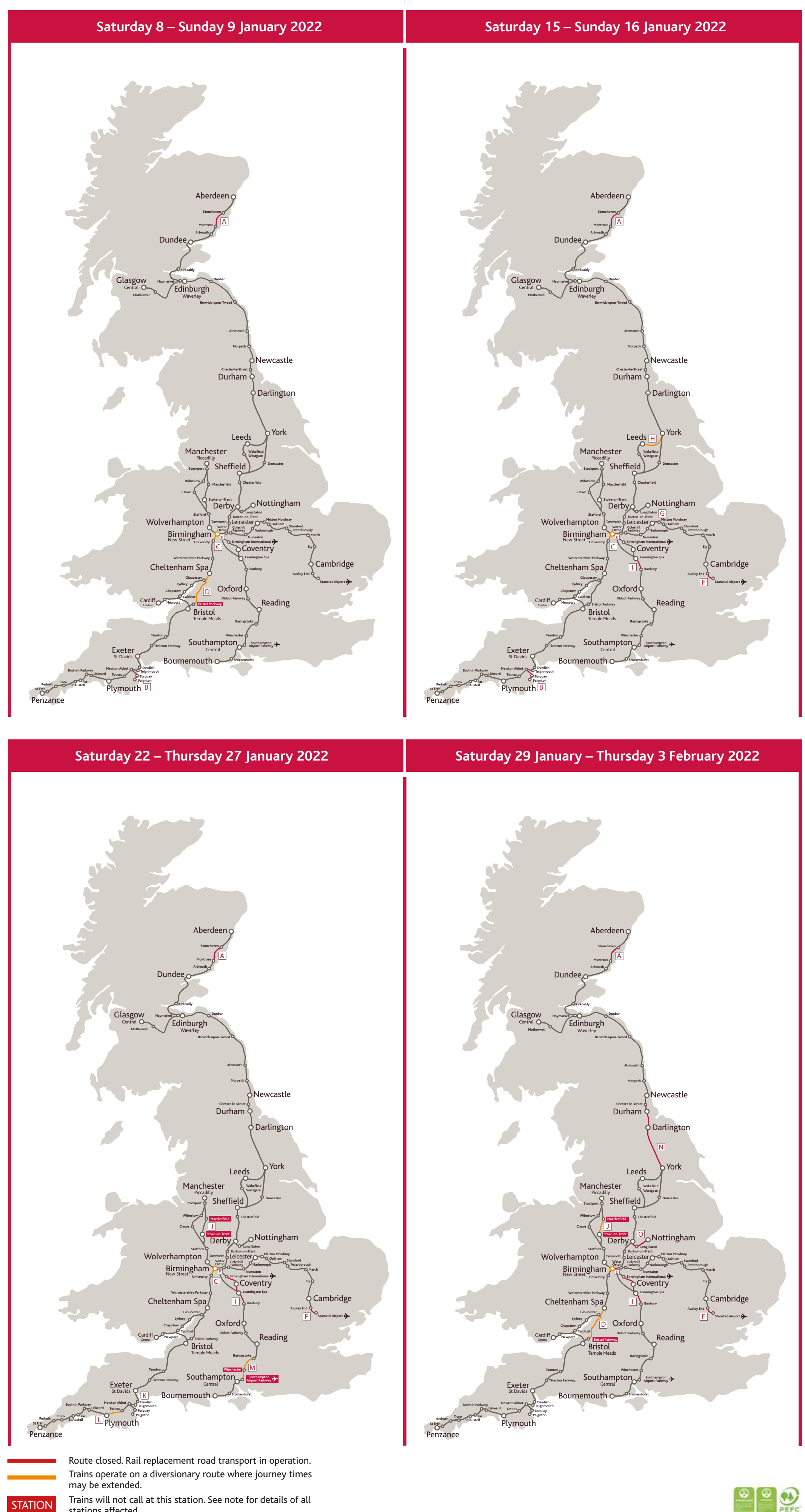
**O Nottingham**  
Monday 31 January – Thursday 3 February from 2350 to 0455 each night

The 2309 Birmingham New Street to Nottingham will terminate at Derby. Rail replacement road transport will operate from Derby to Nottingham.
