

CHANGES TO TRAIN TIMES.

Saturday 07 – Sunday 29 May 2022.

Major track improvement work will be taking place at the locations detailed below during this period. The following details will result in changes to the published timetable.

A Birmingham New Street

Platform 6 Until 08 May
Platform 7 until 05 June

Trains on routes between South West – North East. Leicester – Birmingham New Street & Nottingham – Cardiff Central will be retimed by a few minutes.

B Water Orton

Saturdays 07, 14, 21 from 1045 – Sundays 08, 15, 22 May

Birmingham New Street - Leicester - Stansted Airport services will start and terminate at Coleshill Parkway.

Nottingham - Cardiff Central services will operate between Nottingham and Coleshill Parkway & Birmingham New Street and Cardiff Central.

Trains to/from North East and Scotland will divert via an alternative route not calling at Tamworth. Journey times will be extended by one hour.

Rail replacement road transport will operate between -Birmingham New Street, Water Orton and Coleshill Parkway.

-Birmingham New Street, Coleshill Parkway and Nuneaton (Sundays 08, 15 May).

-Birmingham New Street and Tamworth (Sunday 22 May).

C Motherwell

Saturdays 07, 21 from 1130 – Sundays 08, 15, 22, 29 May

Trains will not call at Motherwell. Rail replacement road transport will operate between Motherwell and Edinburgh Waverley.

D University

Sunday 08 May

Trains will not call at University. Rail replacement road transport will run between Birmingham New Street and University.

E Bournemouth

Sundays 08, 15 May

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Bournemouth and Southampton Airport Parkway.

F Plymouth

Monday 09 – Thursday 12 May from 1920 to 0430 each night

0820 Aberdeen to Plymouth, 1642 Birmingham New Street to Plymouth, 11305 Edinburgh Waverley to Plymouth and 1508 Edinburgh Waverley to Plymouth will run a few minutes later into Plymouth.

G Melton Mowbray

Saturday 28 – Sunday 29 May

Rail replacement road transport will operate between Leicester and Melton Mowbray.

H Sheffield

Sunday 29 May

Trains will be retimed by approximately 15 between Chesterfield and Sheffield.
